

Ecosan Training for Trainers of Public Health Inspectors at National Institute for Health Science, Kalutara, January 21 – 25, 2008

The ecosan training targeted the Supervising Public Health Inspectors (SPHIs), the tutors of PHIs, and the Medical Officers of Health. The SPHIs and MOHs will disseminate the knowledge in the field, whereas the tutors will pass on the knowledge to the next generation of PHIs. The training was conducted by seecon International and funded by IFRC/SEI.
